Smoky Hill River Clean Up

Saturday, March 28

The Volunteer Connection is recruiting volunteers for a Smoky Hill River Cleanup, Saturday, March 28, beginning at 8:00 a.m. at Kenwood Park Shelter. Volunteers will be either picking up trash from the river banks and bed or dragging cut limbs and brush to piles to be loaded into trucks. Participants should wear sturdy, closed-toe shoes, long-sleeved shirts and long pants and bring sunscreen. Water will be provided; volunteers are strongly encouraged to bring their personal, re-usable water containers.
